As part of the annual Youth Directors Conference (YDC) and then continuing throughout the year, the Life After High School Program (LAHS) encourages students to attend college after high school by developing good study habits and exposing them to higher education opportunities at an early age. The LAHS program, beginning during the YDP Conference and culminating with the Summer Pre-College Immersion Program, encourages children to consider careers in education and become teachers in their communities. Many of these students are first generation college students who have an added incentive to return to their neighborhood communities due to their SFAPAL connections, leadership attributes, and college training.

<u>Leadership development, mentoring, and exposure to career opportunities via continuing education after high</u> <u>school.</u>

e. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

More than 800 middle school and high school students in 2018.

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

<u>More youth will attend the program and will continue their education after high school by attending college</u> and avoiding getting into trouble. Too many children get into trouble and continue that trend into adulthood. Using the Kids Trax Program, SFAPAL can track children at each stage of the year long process including: training sessions, meetings, volunteer work, attendance at events, enrollment into the YDC and LAHS programs, into the re-College immersion program, and eventually as enrolled college students.

<u>The YDC has demonstrated the highest standards of program success over the entire 19-year existence. In the unlikely situation where there is a lack of deliverables, the juvenile justice agency could decrease or discontinue future funding to this program.</u>
