- 4. Project/Program Description:

In June 2015, JFS implemented Rales Rides, a program to provide seniors with transportation to and from the Weisman Delray Community Center (Weisman Center). Rales Rides began with a grant from the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority and matching donor funds which enabled us to purchase two 14-passenger wheelchair accessible buses. The buses run weekdays from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. Passengers are picked up at their door. Rales Rides is a free service that enables frail, disabled, low-income seniors to access numerous programs at one location. In addition to a variety of classes and social activities, seniors can access the full scope of JFS services including counseling, case management, food, financial assistance, and volunteer opportunities. Over the last 2 years, ridership has grown by over 25%. JFS is seeking State funding to purchase an additional vehicle and for operational support.

<u>Rales Rides is a free transportation service that enables frail, disabled, low-income seniors to access numerous</u> programs at one location; the Weisman Delray Community Center. In addition to a variety of classes and socialization activities, seniors can access the full scope of JFS services on-site including counseling, case management, support groups, food (JFS food pantry packages can be picked up at the center), financial assistance, and volunteer opportunities. An appropriation will enable JFS to provide transportation to seniors who we are currently unable to serve, due to having only 2 vehicles, 1 full-time and 1 part-time driver.

<u>The seniors ages 60 - 100 years old living in West Delray Beach, West Boca Raton, and South Boynton Beach.</u> <u>9,500 rides will be provided</u>
