HCC is one of the largest post-secondary providers of registered apprenticeship training programs in Florida.HCC's apprenticeship programs are offered in partnership with Associated Builders and Contractors, Independent Electrical Contractors, UA Local 123, Plumbing and Pipefitting, UA Local 821, Sprinkler Fitters, and serves over 500 students annually.

Student performance data will be collected to include pre and post basic skills test results and the number of certifications/licenses earned, the number of residential and commercial building permits, tracking pre and post employment data related to the construction sector, and tracking pre and post economic data and quality of life standards.
