a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of this project is to improve the learning and work environment at LSSC and further protect individuals from harm.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

New monitoring system, including digital cameras, emergency lighting, and building access controls will be installed to improve security and prevent criminal activity. New fire panels will be installed to prevent loss of life and property. Security personnel will also be added to expand the hours which the campuses are monitored.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

A feeling of safety and satisfaction. Citizens will benefit from the improved protection services and feel safer on LSSC campuses. The college's physical assets will also be further protected from loss or harm.

  - High school students 3,000 annually, Community citizens, including the elderly 5,000 annually, University/College students 10,000 annually.
