a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

The summer outreach program will provide a tool to recruit underrepresented populations into STEM programs, which ultimately improves campus and workforce diversity. In addition, the program will serve the state and industry by introducing more students to STEM programs and potentially increasing the number of STEM degrees awarded.

- b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
 - Students will be provided with instruction from university faculty, housing and chaperones. Curriculum already developed as a pilot program will be enhanced through a partnership with the MIT Beaver Works Summer Institute, a rigorous world-class STEM program for talented high school students.
- c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?
 - Students will receive instruction, participate in hands-on STEM projects, and have opportunities to engage in activities that encourage them to seek a college degree in a STEM field.
- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

 This program will serve high school students from traditionally underserved groups.
- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
 - The summer program will diversify the university campus by recruiting underrepresented students, serve the state and industry by introducing more students to STEM programs and produce more STEM degrees. Success will be measured by university diversity and graduation measures, and Florida employment measures.

 - Reduction in funds; program review; reversion of remaining funds.
