To construct a 4,000 sq. ft. Agricultural Training/Conference Center building at \$150 per sq. ft. located adjacent to the Hardee County Agri-Civic Center & the County Extension/University of Florida Institute of Food & Agricultural Sciences Center that will accommodate up to 200 people & will have the capability to be sectioned into 2 separate rooms that would accommodate 80-100 on each side. Facility would offer a size variety based on needs of the conference or training being offered, whether the needs require 200 people or 100 or less. The location is close to current restroom facilities of the Agri-Civic Center that serves as local hub for a lot of agricultural, education, Fair Association, schools, civic & community events that could utilize them making this project more cost effective. Hardee County is a Rural Area of Economic Opportunity.

Purpose is to design and construct a 4,000 sq.ft. agricultural educational training conference center to meet the demand for a facility that will accommodate up to 200 persons allowing to hold affordable educational/training programs/seminars & events, providing employment opportunities, increase of tourism & revenues.

Contractual architectural/engineering for final design and a set of construction plans, permitting, bidding, project management and construction of 4,000 sq. ft. facility to meet the demand for a facility that will accommodate up to 200 persons allowing to hold affordable educational programs/seminars & events.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

Once completed, the conference center provides the opportunity to host affordable educational/training programs/seminars to be attended by interested parties, i.e., students, elderly, special needs, residents, visitors, and the business community from the County and surrounding communities.
