a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

These funds will be used to complete the final phase of CR 466A in Fruitland Park. CR 466A is a major roadway which begins at US 27 in Lake County and extends west to The Villages and US 301 in Sumter County. The total project cost is \$28.5 million Lake County, The Villages, and FDOT have invested \$21 million into the project construction to date. An additional \$7.5 million is needed to complete the project. Design has been completed. Right of Way acquisition will be completed prior to construction.

- b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
 The requested funds will complete the four lane CR 466A widening project from US 441 to Sumter County.
- c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?
 The four lane widening will provide increased capacity and safety and reduced travel times along the corridor.
- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

 All citizens and business interests in the region.
- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefits are improved traffic conditions by increased traffic capacity (FDOT level of service method), increased economic development and activity (results of increased revenue to the CRA), improved storm water management with an increase in acres of roadway with direct discharge (evaluation of acreage now treated for storm water discharge), and the creation of construction jobs (job survey of the contractor).

 Standard contract penalties.
