 Funds will be spent on the construction phase (flowways, ponds, uplands and ditches) of this hydrologic restoration project.

 - Water quality enhancement, reduced flooding in neighborhoods, protection of listed species and wildlife habitat improvement.

 - Reduced flooding will be monitored by tracking flood insurance claims and measuring water volume and flow rates; water quality enhancement will be tracked through the County's ongoing TMDL monitoring; species restoration will be tracked through the County's ongoing environmental monitoring.
