a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds will assist in the completion of phase 2 of the construction of our new facility. Phase 2 of construction includes a museum dedicated to the Florida Cowboy, kitchen, offices and the contestant hospitality area. The completion of these areas will allow us to consistently host larger more multifaceted events.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

- Professional equestrian competitions - Youth Rodeo Events - 4-H and FFA equine and beef events - Safe Haven for displaced animals during disasters. (will greatly compliment the Turner Agri-Civic Center which is located directly west and has been used as a shelter, FEMA distribution site and Food For Florida site.) - Various non-equine events.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

The professional equestrian competitions also serve as fundraisers for local youth organization such as Desoto Band Boosters, JROTC, Desoto/Sarsota Boys and Girls Club, Boy Scouts Troop 39, Desoto 4-H and Desoto FFA. We have a successful youth rodeo program that host approximately 170 youth from Desoto, Hardee, Charlotte and Manatee counties. Students compete for points to qualify for the finals where they can win money and prizes. Scholarships are also provided to qualifying graduating senior. Participants must keep a C grade average in order to compete and log 25 volunteer hours. The facility will also be a safe haven for displaced animals during natural disasters which will greatly compliment the Turner Agri-Civic Center which is a shelter and/or FEMA distribution site.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

At Youth Risk, Grade School Students, High School Students, University/College Students, General(No specific Group). 100,000 to 150,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Enrich Cultural Experience - Phase 2 includes finishes to the William "Kayo" G. Welles Florida Cowboy Museum. Our goal is for it to become a hub for history buffs and a place to educate local youth. It is our goal to host 10 class field trips to the museum. The Desoto County Historical Society and Desoto County Schools will assist in measuring the benefit or outcome. Improve Agriculural Education - We will host multiple events for the Desoto 4-H and FFA including a horse camp, horsemanship workshop and beef shows. It is our goal to host 4 events directly related to the 4-H and FFA. The 4-H and FFA will assist measuring the benefit or outcome. Increase Tourism - As mentioned in the Policom Impact Report, 94% of spectators to the professional rodeos are from outside of Desoto county. This will increase due to increased events, capacity and marketing. We track the amount and type ticketing system.
