MACtown seeks to provide its Treasure Coast clients with a greater continuum of services that will better prepare such individuals to successfully integrate into society. Such services provided within the scope of practice include: nutrition, physical fitness, healthy food choices, computer/interactive technology, and vocational training (i.e. Horticulture/Commercial Kitchen/Hospitality/Retail/Recreation).

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Curriculum and classes will be tailored to meet the clients specific educational and physical needs and goals. Classes will include Interactive White Board (Promethean Board), vocational/supported employment skills and training, community integration and computer lab. The center will offer a selection of specialized exercise equipment that will maximize results and ensure individual health success. Additionally, there will be specialized flooring for aerobic step, dance, muscle conditioning and yoga classes. Healthy choice classes will be provided to educate the clients on eating habits, shopping and preparation of meals.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

There will be the addition of direct care services that provide horticultural training, culinary training, hospitality training, retail training, and recreational activity.
