4. Project/Program Description:

The goal of this project is to provide support for on-going local television programming productions highlighting educational initiatives in and around the Tampa Bay area. These programs focus on science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics (STEM/STEAM). Currently, Tampa Educational Cable Consortium Inc. d/b/a Tampa Bay Arts & Education Network (TBAE) produces (3) local program series' in support of STEM/STEAM education, which include S.T.E.A.M. Ahead!, Innovators in Science and Evening Tide Talks at The Florida Aquarium. These programs will air on TBAE and Hillsborough Schools TV carried by both Spectrum and Frontier cable systems in Hillsborough County. To reach an even greater audience, TBAE will publish each program to its free on-demand streaming service located at watch.tbae.net and provide license-free replays to all other educational cable access channels in the State of Florida.

However, though online distribution and no-cost licensing to other educational cable stations in Florida, that population will be significantly expanded to include all students and residents of Florida (and beyond).
