- 1. Title of Project: Bayhead Rec. Complex and Action Park Reconstruction

- 4. Project/Program Description:

The City of Largo requests funding to assist in the reconstruction of an existing recreation building and amenities at the Bayhead Recreation Complex and Action Park, immediately adjacent to downtown Largo. Reconstruction would allow the site to continue to provide a variety of refurbished outdoor recreation amenities (including parking and restrooms) after school recreation programs, summer camps and school breaks, and income generating rentals. The outdoor, lighted basketball and sand volleyball courts; 7,000 sq. foot, lighted concrete skate and freestyle bike park with bowl; dog park; picnic tables; benches; pond; and open space are frequently used by park patrons, especially youth, teens, and young adults. Reconstruction would allow the site to provide performing arts classes/events for all ages. The sand volleyball courts create a regional tourism amenity. Currently underway is a city-funded, \$70,000 feasibility study and master plan for the facility.

11. Program Performance:

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

Reconstruction of the Bayhead Recreation Complex and Action Park: The existing recreation building is 50+ years old. Reconstruction will allow the site to continue to provide a variety of refurbished outdoor recreation amenities (including parking area) and summer camps with indoor/outdoor restrooms that are used for programs and income generating rentals.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Active and passive recreation, including out-of-school time recreation programs and summer camps; health classes/events; performing arts classes/programing for all ages.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

Out-of-school time recreation and summer camp programming, health classes/events, performing arts classes/programming, regional volleyball tournaments and league play, pick-up basketball games, and league play.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The lighted outdoor basketball and volleyball courts, lighted skateboard park, dog park and open space are frequently used by park patrons, especially youth, teens, and young adults. The recreation complex serves over 2,500+ individuals/month or 30,000+ individuals/year.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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Youth enrolled in out-of-school time recreation and summer programs; Number of participants engaged in active recreation and health classes/events; Number of participants in performing arts classes/events due to upgraded classroom amenity; Leverage the variety of city venues to reach/attract a broader audience for city events. Methodology: Participant data.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

Penalty clauses for missing milestones or not maintaining adequate progress, thus endangering performance of the contract; penalties might include reduction and/or loss of state appropriation. Project completion proposed within 12 months of a competitive procurement process concluding.
