4. Project/Program Description:

The requested funds will be used to acquire a conservation easement over the 6,946-acre Two Rivers Ranch property located in northeast Hillsborough County. The conservation easement will provide: 1) permanent protection of the last major undeveloped property within the Hillsborough River Watershed, which provides a significant portion of the City of Tampa's drinking water; 2) permanent protection of a "landscape-scale" wildlife corridor between Hillsborough River State Park and the County's Blackwater Creek Preserve; and 3) permanent protection of 13 distinct ecological communities providing habitat for 17 threatened or endangered plant and animal species.

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

Acquisition of a conservation easement over the 6,946-acre Two Rivers Ranch property will provide: 1) permanent protection of the last major undeveloped property within the Hillsborough River Watershed, which provides a significant portion of the City of Tampa's drinking water; 2) permanent protection of a "landscape-scale" wildlife corridor between Hillsborough River State Park and the County's Blackwater Creek Preserve; and 3) permanent protection of 13 distinct ecological communities providing habitat for 17 threatened or endangered plant and animal species.

- b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
 - Annual monitoring of the conservation easement by County staff to ensure compliance with all terms and conditions of the easement.
- c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?
 - Protection of surface water quality in the Hillsborough River, which is the major source of drinking water for the City of Tampa. Other ecosystem benefits are provided in section "e" below.
- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
 - Due to the project's wide-ranging water quality and natural systems benefits, the target population served by this project includes all residents of Hillsborough County, or approximately 1.6 million individuals.
- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Providing permanent protection of Two Rivers Ranch will result in over \$51 million in ecosystem benefits to the region. Using EPA models, this is broken down into four areas: flood protection (\$41 million), stable climate (\$3 million), usable air (\$1 million), and usable water (\$6 million).

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

Prohibited uses of the property are outlined in the conservation easement agreement. Notices of violation may be issued by the County and, if not addressed in a timely manner by the landowner, could result in mediation by both parties or potentially litigation.
