11. Program Performance:

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

Provide organized and drop-in recreational sports activities through the construction of outdoor playfields to allow for participation in such activities as baseball/softball, soccer, and basketball as well as outdoor playground equipment for young children and families.

- b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
 - Through collaboration with area recreation service providers (YMCA, municipalities, local schools) underserved children in the Highpoint community will have the opportunity to play in organized and drop-in sports programs and activities, which are currently not available to this community.
- c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?
 - Provide active recreation facilities and programs to economically disadvantaged youth who currently do not have access to sports facilities, provide a community gathering place for residents to gather in both structured and non-structured recreational play, and increase the health and well-being of residents through active play and sports activities
- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

 The target population are youth (male and female) from the ages of 5 to 16. The population to be served is expected to be 800+.
- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
 - Physical activity through participation in sports and related activity is proven to be beneficial to the physical and emotional well-being of youth. Organized sports activities are effective at reducing childhood obesity, reducing drug use, and improving social and emotional well-being. Outcomes will be measured by self-reporting surveys, community surveys, tracking juvenile drug arrests in the area, and tracking juvenile arrest recidivism.
- f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?
 Forfeiture of unused funds.

This project is intended to be a joint usage facility between Pinellas County and the Pinellas County School Board (property owner). The Pinellas County School Board would benefit from this project through a joint usage agreement which would allow them use of the facility when not in use by the general public (i.e. during school hours).
