4. Project/Program Description:

As a result of Hurricane Michael, Gulf County's taxable value is now estimated to decrease by 35%. Consequentially, our voted 1 mil will result in a \$485,216 loss of revenue. The impact of such a significant loss is further compounded by a significant drop in student enrollment as well. A decrease in enrollment directly affects FEFP funding. The newly earmarked allocation for Best & Brightest Teacher Scholarship Program adds yet another burden. Based on the Governor's proposal, Gulf District Schools will receive less revenue in the 2019-2020 budget than the beginning 2018-2019 provided. Gulf's total estimated shortfall total \$1,150,435 and represents a crippling blow to the school district. The funds being requested would permit Gulf District Schools to offset this deficit and ensure instructional salaries and benefits continued to be paid at their current level. They would also permit the purchase of needed textbooks.
