11. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds will purchase over 20,000 copies of the Florida Edition of the Vietnam 50th Commemorative Book ("A Time to Honor: Stories of Service, Duty and Sacrifice) and documentary ("The Journey Home") to be given to Florida Vietnam Veterans on a first-come, first serve basis. In collaboration with the Library of Congress, the Vietnam Veterans of America and the Naval Historical Foundation, the Florida-customized edition of this Vietnam 50th commemorative book and documentary is not only a gift of recognition and honor to Vietnam Veterans living in Florida, but it is a strategic communications outreach tool that has been shown to lead to economic and health benefit impact for the veterans. This gift also serves to educate their family members and the community about their service, and is a gift from the state that veterans typically display in their homes that contains 24/7 contact information for crisis and benefits issues.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Over 20,000 Florida Edition books will be printed and distributed (through VA offices and events, and partnering veteran service organizations such as Vietnam Veterans of America. Vietnam Veterans of America Florida chapters will specifically distribute throughout the state at events, screenings, state and county fairs, nursing homes and personal delivery from volunteers ONLY to Florida Vietnam Veterans. This will establish "demand" for additional gifts (outreach tools) to reach more Florida Vietnam veterans and a means for collecting new data on "new" Vietnam veterans not currently in the VA system.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The recognition gift is actually an important strategic communications outreach tool to help Vietnam veterans sign up for federal VA benefits ("new" dollars to the veteran, and thereby the state). 52% of all veterans are not signed up, the majority are Vietnam veterans. Further, according to Secretary of Veterans Affairs Robert Wilkie, "of the 20 veteran suicides daily, 14 of them of them are not in the system....the vast majority of those are Vietnam veterans." This is a direct service to the Vietnam veterans with relevant information about how to get help 24/7 through a call, email, text, chat, in person meeting, on any subject that matters to them. This gift facilitates the outreach in a non-threatening way, while recognizing those who served during a controversial time, and without public support.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The funds will purchase over 20,000 copies of the Florida Edition of the Vietnam 50th Commemorative Book ("A Time to Honor: Stories of Service, Duty and Sacrifice) and documentary ("The Journey Home") to be given to Florida Vietnam Veterans on a first-come, first serve basis.
