Protect the public from harm, improve transportation conditions, increase or improve economic activity, improve wastewater management, stormwater management, groundwater quality, drinking water quality, surface water quality and protect impaired waterbodies. The outcomes will be measured by observing reduced flooding during storm events, the number of redevelopment projects along Golden Gate Parkway, the number of conversions from septic to sewer and a reduction in the level of impairment within critical waterbodies.
