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11. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The construction of the force main will allow for a failing package wastewater treatment plant serving a 36 unit apartment complex to be removed from service providing better service to the residents and reducing the potential for environmental impacts. The force main will also allow for additional economic development along the pipeline route.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funds will be used for the design, permitting, and construction of the force main.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Citizens along the pipeline route will be able to connect to municipal wastewater service.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The initial population to be served is a 36 unit apartment complex, approximately 80 residents. The construction of the force main will allow for the development of a 100 unit residential subdivision, a 788 unit residential subdivision, a 45 unit residential subdivision, a 200 bed assisted living facility and several commercial properties.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The initial benefit of the project is providing reliable wastewater service to the apartment complex, and avoiding the potential for environmental issues related to the failure of the package plant. Additional economic development is also anticipated. The number of connections to the force main will be measured to quantify the benefit.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

Liquidated damages for unjustifiable delays in construction will be incorporated into the contract.

The City of Fruitland Park will receive the funding and will be the owner of the force main.
