	The goal of this project is to enhance school safety measures within the City's public schools by providing school resource officers with the proper tools to rapidly respond to an active assailant threat. The project's purpose is to ensure each school has a safe and secure location to store the assigned school resource officer's tactical equipment and long gun.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	The related activities are to procure and install safes in each City designated public school for use by the assigned school resource officer.
c.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	The students and faculty of each school will be provided with an additional layer of security measures by allowing for a rapid response to an active assailant threat.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	The target population served by this project is the 41,000 students and 5,000 staff members of the Orange County Public Schools within the City of Orlando.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	The expected outcome/benefit of this project is an enhancement to current security measures within the schools by providing rapid response capabilities to the school resource officers. This outcome will be measured through the implementation of the program and the availability of the equipment to the school resource officer.
