Funds will be utilized to construct new stormwater drainage system in order to prevent flood and/or ponding, prevent flood related losses, and provide for proper vehicular traffic to communities along corridor at times of significant rain events.

New stormwater drainage system will be installed: exfiltration trench, inlets, manholes. Pavement and striping along impacted areas.

An improved stormwater system that will properly handle stormwater and will allow for proper access to adjacent communities and vehicular traffic along said corridor.

The expected benefit will be prevention of flooding and/or ponding. The measurement will be: no flooding / ponding visible during normal rain events.
