4. **Project/Program Description**

Drug Free America Foundation would host a 3 day drug prevention summit in collaboration with local prevention and treatment agencies. The goal of the prevention summit is to increase awareness of the impacts of drug use and abuse, enhance knowledge of how to reduce access, change social norms, encourage discussion of current policies and provide professional continuing education credits for prevention professionals, substance abuse treatment counselors, mental health counselors, marriage counselors and a certificate for attending law enforcement. The summit will focus on implementing successful prevention strategies and providing tools to empower communities to advocate for sound drug policies.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Training, prevention and treatment of professional, law enforcement, community volunteers and stakeholders on the the impacts of drug use and abuse, enhance knowledge of how to reduce access, change social norms and encourage discussion of current policies. The summit will focus on implementing successful prevention strategies and providing tools to empower communities to advocate for sound drug policies.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

National experts on drug policy and prevention will be utilized to provide training and continuing education credits will be provided to prevention professionals, substance abuse, mental health and marriage counselors.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The summit will be open for public attendance and by providing professional training to providers throughout the state, citizens will be provided better strategies to prevent initial substance use and education on access to treatment and sustained recovery efforts.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population is professionals working in drug prevention, treatment, recovery, problem solving courts, law enforcement and policy makers. The summit is expected to be attended by 250-400 individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The outcome is increased knowledge by professionals on current drug trends, policies, impact and research. This will be measured by attendance surveys and the filing of continued education credits.
