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1.	Program Performance			
a.	What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?			
	Installation of backup generators on LCSO Administration and Law Enforcement Division Buildings and renovation of Law Enforcement Division Building will ensure effective work space to accommodate the functions of the LCSO and ensure continuity of operations during periods of power outages and natural or man-made disasters.			
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?			
	If funds are appropriated the LCSO will contract to complete the purchase and installation of backup generators for the LCSO Administration and Law Enforcement Buildings and contract to complete the planning, design, and renovation of the existing Law Enforcement Division Building. Completion of these projects will be considered meeting the purpose of this funding.			
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?			
	Citizens will be better served by ensured continuity of operations of the LCSO during periods of power outages, major events, or natural or man-made disasters.			
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?			
	The target population to be served by this project includes the citizens, visitors and businesses operating in or traveling through Liberty County. On a daily basis, this project would serve approximately 8,242 individuals. During the peak visitor season, the number of individuals served rises to over 10,000.			
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?			
	The expected benefit of this project will be ensuring the continuity of operations of the LCSO during periods of power outages, major events, or natural or man-made disasters. Additionally, the renovations to the Law Enforcement Division Building will improve the efficiency of the existing building footprint, and ensure the functionality of the building for the foreseeable future.			
f.	What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?			
	Forfeiture of remaining funds from this appropriation. Repayment of funds already expended associated with this appropriation.
