11. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The proposed improvement to the Sports Complex will provide renovations and improvements needed at the baseball diamonds for the continued development and expansion of tournaments and events which benefit the local economy. The exercise trail is heavily used and the repairs will provide for a safer, user friendly surface. The playground is heavily used and is in the full sun. The shade covering will provide for a safer, fully accessible playground which can be used by children of all ages.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The baseball diamonds will be renovated to include batting cages and the playground will be renovated to include a shade covering. The paved exercise trail currently has several unsafe, degraded areas and it will be resurfaced to provide for a safe trail providing full accessibility to all ages and abilities. The fitness equipment will provide additional exercise and fitness opportunities to the many adults who frequent the trails not only for recreation but also their health.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

In addition to the improvements to the Complex which can be used by all citizens, the Sports Complex has been key in tourism development for the community with multi-day tournaments being hosted at the facility. As a fiscally constrained county, tourism and economic development related to recreation is critical to the community. The county is a designated RAO and REDI community.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is children and families who participate and enjoy outdoor recreation. However, one of the key goals is for the continued development of tournaments and events to benefit the local and regional economy. As the Complex is heavily used year round, 100,000+ individuals are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

A key aspect of the project is the baseball diamonds renovations which will aid in the continued development of tournaments and events at the Complex benefiting the local economy and tourism development. The shade covering at the playground, repairs to the trail system, and additional security lighting will provide for much safer, enhanced outdoor recreational opportunities.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

The county has obtained quotes for the proposed improvements and the design and engineering is complete. When a contract is executed the county will move forward with the project immediately. The county will meet all performance measures within contract timelines.
