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11. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of the program is to improve quality of life and well-being for Broward County residents employed at local businesses, institutions, and nonprofit organizations. Skilled artists will guide participants through hands-on music and art experiences.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

If funded, Art in the Workplace would offer free art classes to approximately 500 employees at Broward County businesses, organizations, and nonprofit organizations. Through creative expressions of art, the health of the community will improve by stimulating positive emotions to decrease stress and anxiety. Businesses for the Arts of Broward use the arts as a vehicle to improve mental health and increase quality of life through innovative and forward-thinking programming that in turn improves employee engagement and retention to support the local community and economy.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Broward County citizens will receive a comprehensive art or music lesson delivered by a professional artist. Participants will learn about the creative history and theory behind the particular art form and integrate that history with their own creativity to create a work of art. Additionally, lessons will be combined with work- or leadership-based topics to foster cohesiveness and collaboration among participants and within the workplace.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Approximately 500 individuals employed at local businesses, institutions, and nonprofit organizations in Broward County will be served by this project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The primary outcome is to improve the mental health of participants, enabling them to experience a reduction in stress and anxiety and an increase in positive emotions through instructor-led art activities. The secondary outcome is to enrich the cultural experience of participants, enabling them to experience increased creativity and self-expression. The success of these outcome are measured by a post-survey and evaluation.

If the program dissolves or fails to perform services, the funds will be returned.
