The reduction in flooding will result in an increase in the number of businesses locating in the area, which will create job opportunities for residents.

	These funds will be utilized for the construction of a drainage system to reduce flooding and increase water quality in a low to moderate income area.

An increase in economic activity: the method for measuring the benefits will be by an increase in home values, the number of new businesses, and new jobs created in the area.
