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11. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Goal is to excavate the remaining 6-1/4 miles navigational channel & construct the embankment for the linear park. Glades County owns the largest area of Lake Okeechobee & access to the Lake is important to the economy. The Moore Haven Canal is the life line for the County that allows direct access to the Lake. Project

provides for protection of State water resources, the public, tourists, visitors, citizenry & residents with safer navigation, improved water flow & filtration, cleaner water & includes allowing for economic development venues to be hosted for fishing, duck hunting, bird watching, hiking, wildlife enthusiasts & activities, etc.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds to be used for contractual engineering & construction services through the County's CCNA procurement policy to excavate the channel & construct the embankment for the linear park that may include, engineering, design survey, soil analysis, permitting, photogrammetry, hydrologic modeling, bidding, earthwork, de-watering, turbidity control, water quality monitoring, mitigation planting, seeding, mulching & planting along the channel embankments, installing navigational aids, clearing & grubbing, wildlife surveys, maintenance of traffic for boaters, record surveys, final quantities, project management, etc.

C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Direct services to citizens is safer navigational waterways, direct access to the Lake, protection of State water resources, improved water flow & water quality.
