For contractual engineering design services of stormwater improvements in the Four Seasons community that includes required legal services to obtain the necessary stormwater utilities easements from property owners. Tasks include preliminary engineering, surveying, permitting, the preparation of appraisals, attorney's fees, recording fees, court costs and/directives of the Court to grant stormwater utility easements on private property. Improvements prevent flooding, allows for safe transportation and ensures the continued health, safety & welfare for the citizenry. The acquisition of critical stormwater utility easements & completion of final design will allow the project to be constructed in this Rural Area of Opportunity. Addresses the permitting agencies water quality/quantity requirements & improved flows.

- a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Purpose is to resolve utility stormwater easement acquisition & complete the project's design. Project allows for reduction of flooding, improved flows, conveyance & inlet improvements to reduce the nutrients & volume of stormwater runoff entering County ditches and public lands. Improves life, health & safety of citizenry.

- b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Contractual engineering design & legal services for stormwater utility easement acquisition through the County's procurement policies & procedures. Design tasks include preliminary engineering, surveying, permitting with the Federal, State & County agencies. Legal services includes the preparation of appraisals, attorney's fees, recording fees, court costs and/directives of the Court to grant stormwater utility easements on private property. The acquisition of critical stormwater utility easements & design will allow the project to be constructed.

- c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Once constructed, direct services include improved life, health & safety by reduced flooding, improved stormwater conveyance and reduction of nutrients entering County ditches and public lands.

- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Four Seasons residents & citizenry, where per capita income is \$17,200, well below the State of Florida's (\$29,838). Greater than 3,100 individuals to be served. Project is located in a Rural Area of Economic Opportunity (s. 288.0656, Florida Statutes).

- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected benefit is acquisition of necessary stormwater utility easements & final design. Measure is a complete set of engineering drawings & appropriate Court required easement acquisition documentation & permits. Meets FDEP & SFWMD programs addressing water quality/quantity stormwater conveyance and treatment. Employment maintained from project.
