The main purpose of this project is the roadway and drainage improvements required for the relocation of approximately 1,700 LF of 16' water main that is required to comply with the FDOT proposed stormwater catch basins required for the roadway and drainage improvements along 74th St. corridor.

This project will entail roadway and drainage improvements and the installation of approximately 1,700 LF of 16' water main.
