а.	What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?
	These funds will restore a critical habitat that is designated as an Outstanding Florida Waterway. This project will also help local governments and agencies to meet a variety water quality improvement mandates (SWIM plans, BMAP plans, Comp plans, etc.) through the reduction of phosphorus and nitrogen
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	SCR will work with our team of contractors to mobilize to a staging site for the dewatering process associated with algal detrital material removal. Once lyngbya is removed from the bottom, then plants (SAV) will be installed & Herbivory Exclusion Cages installed per permit for one year. SAV & cage maintenance will be performed for one year.
c.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Water quality improvements and species recruitment to the area(fish,crustaceans,amphibians, marine mammals)for continued enjoyment of recreational as well as commercial activities crucial to this area (boating, fishing, crabbing, tourism). Tourism dollar increases from restoration of pristine submerged habitat. Increased public usage of improved habitat.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	The citizens and the economy of the State of Florida, Citrus County, and the City of Crystal River, as well as the 350,000 local, national and international visitors per year that visit Kings Bay and the Crystal River waters.
е.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	This project meets the goals of the SWFWMD's SWIM plan for Kings Bay and fits with the statewide focus on the restoration of impaired Florida Outstanding Waterway. Additionally, water quality improvement and increased biodiversity creates a cascade effect that improves downstream habitat.
