c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The club serves as a culinary instructional facility for low-income individuals looking to learn a trade (Feeding Tampa Bay). It also serves as an education facility for seniors looking to learn culinary skills and languages through the USF OLLI Program; and as a historical and cultural enrichment facility for local schools by providing tours and, often times, free lunch to those students.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The Tampa Bay community as a whole would benefit from this appropriation. As the club looks at the next 100 years, it wants to ensure that the mission is preserved for generations to come. Current population within the Tampa Bay region exceeds 3 million, any of whom could benefit from the historical and cultural experiences available in the building.
