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#### 11. Program Performance

##### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

These funds will expand the delivery of FFA programs from 21,000 students to nearly 75,000 students in Florida. Each student enrolled in agricultural education in middle and high school will become an affiliated member of FFA at the local, state and national level.

##### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

FFA makes a positive difference in the lives of students by developing their potential for premier leadership personal growth and career success through agricultural education. FFA staff work to ensure that leadership and career development opportunities are made available for all students. Likewise, FFA staff works with business and industry partners to ensure that each of our events and activities remain rigorous and relevant to the industry and provide the skills necessary to prepare students to be successful in the industry of agriculture.

##### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Of the requested funds, approximately \$700,000 would be used to expand membership affiliation to nearly 70,000 students enrolled in agriculture education. This would be a significant increase from the 18,000 FFA members that are currently served in Florida. As recognized by Federal Law (Public Law 105-225), FFA is an intra-curricular program that is designed to prepare young people in the areas of premier leadership, personal growth and career success, through agricultural education. These funds would ensure that FFA programs and opportunities are available to every student enrolled in agricultural education, including those in underserved populations who would not otherwise be able to join the organization. \$350,000 would be used to enhance the delivery of FFA programming, ensuring that each program is both rigorous and relevant to the agriculture industry. \$250,000 of the requested funds will be used to enhance the FFA Leadership Training Center in Haines City.

##### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Nearly 70,000 students enrolled in Agriculture Education in Florida's middle and high schools.

##### e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

FFA program delivery will increase from 21,000 students to nearly 75,000 students annually. FFA staff will be better equipped and mobilized to support teachers and an increase number of students regarding FFA programming. Enhancements will be made to the FFA Leadership Training Center to better accommodate a growing number of agricultural youth that utilize the facility for leadership and career success training.
