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11. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Union County often holds court events involving high-security state inmates, greatly increasing the public safety concerns that are present in any courthouse. Security screenings will greatly reduce these concerns, increasing the safety of the public and staff in the courthouse.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Staffed entrances with sufficient equipment to provide security screenings and building modifications.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Safety concerns from inmate trials and other court hearings that may be highly emotional for those involved will be greatly reduced.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All residents of Union County, including the state inmate population, plus anyone that will enter the Union County courthouse for any reason. Of the County's 15,000 residents, 5,000 are state inmates.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

A secure and safe courthouse. Security screenings will be conducted during operating hours.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

Extreme public safety concerns, mostly arising from state inmates that may be in the Union County courthouse for incidents occurring in the Department of Corrections institutions. Many of these defendants have gang affiliations and/or are high-security inmates.
