Center, Marion CI, Lowell CI, Central Florida Reception Center, Zephyrhills CI, Orlando CRC, Kissimmee CRC and St. Petersburg CRC.

|    | Resume building, speech proficiency, interview training, role play and employer expectations are primary in what is being taught.  |
| c. | What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?  |
|    | As a result of the funding, over two thousand inmates will receive comprehensive vocational training and be placed with an employer. The program will provide long-term, full time employment to these adult inmates throughout the state of Florida. There is a 30% recidivism rate for inmates within the first three years of release. There is also a 15% recidivism over three years for work release inmates. The proportional average of this is a 25% recidivism over three years.             |
|    | Character Speaks expects at least 50% of graduates to get a job within three weeks of being released from a DOC facility. The following is a more detailed explanation of the savings to the state.  |
| d. | Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?   |
|    | The total number of people served will be 2,080. Out of those 2,080 students, 1,248 will be inmates in prison and 832 will be at various work release facilities across the state. We will coordinate with the chamber of commerce in every mid to large city in the state so inmates have employers to send resumes to immediately upon release.  |
| e. | What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?   |
|    | After nearly three years of classes, CSARP has had over 500 students complete our program at the Santa Fe Bridge Work Release Center in Gainesville. Every student has gained employment upon completion of the program. Thus far, we had 22 students who have had behavioral issues and have been sent back to prison. That number constitutes less than 5% of the total students served. Even those students who have had behavioral issues gained employment after they graduated from our program. |
|    | We anticipate at least 50% of our students to gain employment upon release from prison.  |
