a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

	Relocating the water supply to a new well field will eliminate or significantly reduce TTHM, HAA5 and the tannic coloration in drinking water and well as eliminating the water color and contamination issues throughout distribution system. The current wells are located within 1000 feet of the stormwater collection point contributing to organic contamination of the water supply. The Suwannee River Water Management District completed the wellfield siting report and acquired the site. This request will install the new wells and connect to the existing Treatment plant. This grant will also reduce need for treatment processes at the plant.				
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?				
	These funds will be used to construct the well field, water distribution lines to the treatment plant, tanks and all appurtenances necessary to replace the water supply.				
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?				
	This project will provide clean drinking water citizens in Fort White and the Columbia County schools in the town. Currently, the water is undrinkable and many residents and students have to use bottled water.				
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?				
	The Town of Fort White serves 400 residents. Additionally, over 2,000 students attend the elementary, middle and high schools t				
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?				
	This project will provide improved water quality and reduced coloration of the water as measured by FDEP water quality testing, Additionally, the improved water source will allow reduced treatment required by FDEP that address the current contamination. The Town has failed recent FDEP testing for TTHM and HAA5 and has to increase the treatment of the water system.				
f.	What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?				
	The Town would be required to repay the funds should it fail to meet the contract.
