Construction/Renovation/ Land/Planning Engineering	The requested funding will be used to renovate and expand the 50-year old Smith-Brown Gymnasium that currently sits adjacent to the current Louis and Gloria Flanzer Boys & Girls Club (formerly the Smith-Brown schoolhouse). This funding would expand the amount of space available and thus expand the number of children served and programs offered. It will become a multi-use space adding additional classroom, educational, and recreational space.	500,000

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a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of the funds would be to renovate and expand the on-site gymnasium to be re-purposed for additional classroom, recreational, and enrichment space. This would expand the capacity and reach of the Louis and Gloria Boys & Girls Club. The club currently serves 75 children in the nearby schoolhouse but, with the renovation and expansion of the gym, the club would see a significant expansion to the amount of available space and thus expand the number of children served and programs offered.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The current Louis and Gloria Flanzer Boys & Girls Club is a safe space in the middle of public housing to ensure those who need services the most are the ones receiving them. The club offers supplemental learning, which largely focuses on academic success and healthy lifestyles to help participants reach their full potential, achieve on-time grade advancement, and have a plan for the future. However, the limited space limits the amount of children that can be served as well as the number of programs offered. With the renovated gymnasium, programs in the arts, career and workforce development, and character and leadership development can be expanded to help significantly more than the current 75 club members succeed in school and in life. The central focus of these programs is to break the cycle of intergenerational poverty to create well-rounded, responsible students and citizens who will be self-sustaining future leaders of the community.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The renovated and expanded facility will more than triple the amount of safe club space and thus the capacity for the number of members served. This will result in more club members being helped in creating their own paths for success to become self-sustaining and gainfully employed future leaders of the community. They will be provided with supplemental educational programming aimed at ensuring on-time grade advancement as well as instilling healthy lifestyle habits and developing character and leadership skills. Through partnerships with local schools, the club can serve each student in the areas they specifically need improvement in or have interests in. Additional benefits include better academic performance, increased physical activity and knowledge about healthy living, increased socio-emotional skills and awareness, nutritious snacks and meals, and leadership development.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population are at-risk youth between the ages of 6 and 18 years old. Currently, the club is at capacity with 75 children, ages 6 to 11, being served. The club expects that capacity to increase to at least 200 upon completion of the renovation and expansion of the on-site gymnasium, including being able to begin serving local teens.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expect significant increases in academic success, physical and mental well-being, and character and leadership development to help each child reach full potential with a plan for the future after high school. Expect 80% of club members to achieve a "C" in reading and language arts, increased knowledge of avoiding risky behaviors and situations, increased knowledge and engagement in healthy behaviors, while also becoming more physically active and healthy. The goal is that 100% will achieve on-time grade advancement and graduate high school on time with a plan for the future. The methodology by which these will be judged are through on-site pre- and post-test performance reviews and participation levels and quarterly grade tracking through a strong partnership with the local Arcadia schools whose students are served. The club has certified teachers on staff to appropriately help students with homework and academic assistance.

Failure to meet deliverables should result in a probationary period for the organization from receiving state funds.

The City of Arcadia has partnered with the club on this project by providing a 25-year lease for \$1 a year and an agreement to pay utilities throughout the term of the lease.
