The purpose of this funding is to preserve the historic George Guida, Sr. House in West Tampa. This two-story modern movement style structure is owned by the City of Tampa and located in MacFarlane Park. The Guida House is on the National Register of Historic Places due to its local significance as a distinctive West Tampa landmark and as an example of Florida's mid-century, postwar architecture. George Guida, Sr., was a prominent businessman and civic leader in the West Tampa neighborhood, and his home became a gathering place for state and local political leaders, Latin families celebrating weddings and other events, and school and church functions. The house has sat empty since 1984 and needs an estimated \$1 million in structural work.

- a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Renovations to the Guida House, a building constructed in 1954 and listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Restoration and repair work will allow the residents of West Tampa to preserve an existing community asset for public functions and programs.

- b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

A historically appropriate and comprehensive engineering, planning, and construction program to preserve and reactivate this property. These funds will be spent on construction only.

- c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The City of Tampa will use the home as a community center with diverse programming for families that live in the area.

- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

As a community center, the Guida House will serve over 500 children through programs and 5,000 residents who attend events at the property.

- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Exposure to a historic and culturally-significant resource with an opportunity to learn about the West Tampa's history; and access to community programs and services.

Standard penalties are adequate.
