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The College has received approximately \$8.6 million in federal CARES Grant funding. The vast majority of this money was for student financial aid, tuition refunds/waivers, technology and software costs, replacement of bookstore revenues, personal protective equipment, sanitizing and disinfecting, and related costs.

None of the money was for facilities renovations.

#### 12. Program Performance

#### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Replacement of 20-year old roof system, and renovation of the building envelope.

Replacement of HVAC systems and installation of Fire Suppression System.

The Facility Condition Index for this building is 12.21%, which defines the building condition as "poor."

#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Replacement of 20-year old roof system, and renovation of the building envelope.

Replacement of HVAC systems and installation of Fire Suppression System.

This 45-year old bldg. once housed institutional support depts, a dining hall, a bookstore, faculty offices and assembly spaces.

These uses have since been relocated to the College's new Student Services Building.

This building will be completely renovated to house the College's Hospitality and Tourism laboratory spaces.

#### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Total renovation of building to house the College's Hospitality and Tourism lab spaces. New roof and sealing of the building exterior to eliminate leaks.

Upgraded HVAC system to improve indoor air quality and help prevent airborne transmission of viruses such as SARS-CoV2.

#### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?



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College students, high school students, unemployed persons, persons with poor physical health, economically disadvantaged persons, and general population by maintaining and optimizing the use of this taxpayer-owned building. Numerous services have been moved to the new Student Center. Spaces here need to be renovated to house the College's Hospitality & Tourism labs. We expect a >100% % utilization rate when renovations are complete. Meeting spaces are now used daily.

### e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Improve health by eliminating leaks, mold, etc.

Measure by routine monitoring of air quality and leak inspections. Students completing tourism and hospitality course requirements.

Measure by course completion and graduation rates. Employment of persons during the renovation work. Measure by number of persons employed by contractors.

Benefit taxpayers by extending the useful life of this state-owned asset.

## f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Deliverables under this project will be the replacement of the roof, sealing of the leaky building envelope and replacement of an HVAC system which has outlived its useful life.

Seminole State College has standard performance clauses in all of its contracts which assure that all work will be completed in accordance with the work plan and list of deliverables, including regarding the payment and withholding of funds as necessary.

It is not anticipated that additional penalties will be needed.

### 13. The owners of the facility to receive, directly or indirectly, any fixed capital outlay funding. Include the relationship between the owners of the facility and the entity.

Seminole State College is a public institution of higher education, offering education leading to Associates and Bachelor's Degrees, as well as numerous shorter-term, work-related certificates.

The taxpayers of Florida, through the State, own and benefit from the building.
