12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Support individuals with disabilities; enhance their self-advocacy, adaptive, vocational, work preparation and/or social skills through instruction and/or hands-on training as well as various educational and enrichment activities. Funds would be used to maintain or expand our degreed, credentialed and professional staff with skill-sets required to provide services listed above; with limited and/or decreased funding, the opportunity for individuals with disabilities to learn life skills and become vocationally/economically independent will not occur.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Comprehensive, individually tailored vocational training programs, supported employment, or other support services that provide sufficient skills, knowledge and understanding to increase the capability of individuals with disabilities in areas of self-help, adaptive or securing/maintaining competitive jobs in the community; enrichment and educational activities aiming to improve both their motor and socialization skills will also be provided

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Provide an opportunity for individuals with disabilities to become vocationally and economically independent through instruction or hands-on training related to each person's "Individual Annual Plan." This plan is created by our professional team one-on-one with each and every individual, with prescribed goals, which are then tracked by our professional team. Opportunities in areas such as vocational training, supported employment and other work preparation services are also offered.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?



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Target populations include individuals with intellectual, or developmental, or mental, or physical disabilities, or economically disadvantaged persons, or jobless persons. 225 individuals in the target populations are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected outcomes are as follows: improving mental health - 70% of those served will increase their ability to cope with situations that arise during the workday, with quarterly reporting on progress of client goals which are determined in each and every clients' annual meeting; improving quality of education - 70% of those served will meet their educational goals, with quarterly reporting on progress of goals which were determined in each and every clients' annual meeting; enhance specific individual's economic self sufficiency - clients will receive pre-vocational, vocational or work preparation training with 70% of these clients achieving pre-vocational, vocational or work preparation goals
