12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To institute a new K-8 International Baccalaureate Arts and Innovation Magnet Academy in south Hillsborough County - a Magnet School "desert" - in order to develop a diverse student population, engage students and families with innovative programs, and train teachers in the latest pedagogical strategies

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funding will establish and market this unique magnet offering to students and their families. The dollars will be dedicated to outfitting the school with appropriate cutting-edge technology, such as augmented/virtual reality and graphics design labs, begin the authorization process to become an IB and Project Lead the Way site, and to provide supplies and materials that will help the school "scream" its theme.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Funding will be utilized to provide students with high-interest programming such as graphic design, augmented reality, engineering, robotics, and global exploration. Teachers will receive high-quality professional development to assist each student in meeting his or her needs.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

As there will not be boundaries at this school, the target population is students in grades kindergarten through 8 from around the district. We expect to serve 1,200 students.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will



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be measured?

Hillsborough County Public Schools will provide an innovative magnet option for families in the southern portion of Hillsborough County by establishing a K-8 IB STEAM Magnet Academy. Student enrollment in the magnet program will be the methodology by which this outcome will be measured.
