a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The specific purposes that will be achieved by the funds being requested are a reduction in localized flooding, standing rainwater, and the probability of mosquito-transmitted diseases to the public.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Flood mitigation activities, including the design, permitting, and construction of the drainage system comprised of drainage pipes, exfiltration trenches (French drains), and asphalt restoration on NW 159th Terrace, from NW 79th Avenue to NW 77th Place.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Flood mitigation activities to further reduce or eliminate the risk of repetitive flood damage in the Royal Oaks community.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population served by this project is the Royal Oaks residential community in Miami Lakes. The project will directly impact approximately 25-30 homes, as well as the Bob Graham Education Center, located at 15901 NW 79th Avenue in Miami Lakes.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected benefits include improved drainage, reduced localized flooding, increased drainage capacity, improved stormwater management, eliminated standing rainwater, reduced probability of mosquito-transmitted diseases to the public, and reduced impact to property and life. Outcome will be measured by field inspection and documentation of rainfall events.
