a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The requested funding will improve stormwater runoff from this collection canal outfalling to the Hillsboro Canal (G-08).

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funding will provide for excavation and re-establishment of proper grade/invert of the canal, stabilization of the canal bank, construction of a new head wall and related water quality improvements.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Funds will be used for construction and restoration costs of project.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

There are approximately seventy property owners immediately adjacent to the canal. Another 200 properties runoff into this canal. Water quality improvement would benefit residents far beyond those serviced by the canal.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected benefits of the project are twofold. First, improved stormwater runoff. Second, an improvement in stormwater runoff quality. Runoff will contain far less sediment and fewer contaminants as the drainage canal discharges into the larger Hillsboro Canal.

No additional penalties are contemplated at this time.
