The Miami-Dade Department of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) currently has 6 truck-mounted adulticiding sprayers which constantly have mechanical problems due to aging and extensive use. These sprayers are operated daily; however, once they malfunction we lose the window of opportunity to treat for nuisance and disease threats. It is crucial to have working adulticiding equipment to ensure the protection of Miami-Dade County residents against mosquito borne diseases. Therefore, dependable sprayers are needed to aid in the eradication of mosquitoes.

Miami-Dade County, as a whole, received up to \$474 million in CARES Act funds.
