a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Expanded access to project based civics education through the Florida YMCA Youth In Government program serving middle and high school students across the state of Florida.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

We host three statewide assemblies per year and local/regional events throughout the year including weekly meetings at the host schools, service projects, and servant leadership conferences. We teach civics, servant leadership, advocacy and the legislative process.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Project based civic education and service opportunities for middle and high school students and collegiate mentors.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is high school and middle school students and teachers. The program is currently serving over 800 individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

We provide hands-on learning experiences that supplement what students are learning in the classroom. Students have the option to participate in a year-round, multi-year youth development opportunity with success measured through student surveys and completion of the program.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?
