a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Funds requested will support capital construction for habitat restoration projects designed to improve water quality, habitat quality and resiliency of the eastern shoreline of Lake Okeechobee. Water quality benefits will include areas downstream of the lake, including Palm Beach County and Martin County, along with the Loxahatchee River, St. Lucie River Estuary and the Lake Worth Lagoon.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds will be utilized entirely for capital costs associated with finalization of project design and subsequent construction activities.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct and secondary improvements to water quality, habitat quality and resilience within the lake and in downstream/receiving water bodies.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by this effort and associated projects includes the residents and numerous visitors of Palm Beach County.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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Benefits will include the creation of near-shore freshwater littoral habitat to improve the water quality, ecological conditions and coastal resiliency of Lake Okeechobee. Methodologies to measure expected benefits of these efforts include water quality and biological monitoring, and the acreage of habitat created/restored.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

None. Palm Beach County has an outstanding track record of performance with environmental appropriations and grants.
