## 4. Project/Program Description

Funds will be used to fill an unnecessary ditch (S-20 Collector Canal), disable two nearby unneeded culverts that impact regional Everglades wetlands hydrology, and restore wetlands near the coast in southern Miami-Dade County. This project will enhance water retention and wetland recharge potential to address salt intrusion in the Biscayne Aquifer near municipal wellfields, including those under the jurisdiction of Miami-Dade County and the Florida Keys Aqueduct Authority. This ditch is not part of the Central and South Florida Flood Control Project.

This project will improve water management, reduce salt water intrusion and restore publicly owned wetlands in Miami-Dade County in the southern Everglades, a region located east of Everglades National Park.
