	For more than two decades, Seminole County has been working cooperatively with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP), Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC), and the St. Johns River Water Management District (SJRWMD), as well as impacted municipalities, on the assessment and subsequent multipronged approach to the restoration of Lake Jesup. This project is part of Seminole County's Stormwater Master Plan and the FDEP Lake Jesup BMAP documents. It will provide water quality improvements, biological diversity and ecology, prevention of fish kills and toxic algal blooms, resulting in opportunities for long-term water quality improvements and increased recreational use of Lake Jesup.
