### 12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The intent of this project is to increase safety along this roadway and to save lives. On numerous occasions, the extreme proximity of the canal has led to serious injuries and even deaths as it is simply too easy for vehicles to run off the road and into the canal due to the lack of guardrails or other approved barriers.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Safety guardrail will be installed on Appaloosa Trail between the edge of pavement and the canal bank from Stirling Road (State Road 848) to Old Sheridan Street (approximately 5,300 linear feet total) to increase safety along this roadway and to save lives.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Business recruitment, job creation, and related economic opportunities will be enhanced for the state and the town's adjacent municipalities by providing a safer corridor. This construction project will employ nearly 40 Floridians within the next year, including all of the construction jobs, and create permanent jobs in the nearby businesses.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The installation of guardrail along Appaloosa Trail will dramatically increase the safety of the thousands of motorists that traverse it each day, allowing the traveling public to conduct business with local merchants and companies that directly access this roadway.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The intent of this project is to increase safety along this roadway and to save lives. This will be measured by the number of accidents on the roadway.
