The project includes the design, permitting, bidding and construction of a wastewater collection system and wastewater force main pumping system to serve approximately 370 customers within Unit 1 of the Port LaBelle Utility System. The gravity collection system will collect and transfer wastewater to a wastewater pump station. The pump station will then pump the wastewater to the existing Port LaBelle Wastewater Treatment Plant. This project is in the Caloosahatchee BMAP area.

The goal is to expand the wastewater service to approximately 370 residential units, thereby eliminating on-site septic tank systems.

#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funds will be used to perform design, permitting, bidding and construction services associated with the sewer system expansion.

#### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Wastewater collection and ultimately treatment and effluent disposal, thereby eliminating the need for on-site septic tank systems.

#### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the 950 residents who utilize the Port LaBelle Utility System.

# e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit is the ability to provide centralized wastewater service to customers within the Port LaBelle Utility System service area, thereby eliminating on-site septic tank systems.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?



Hendry County and the Department of Health have an agreement requiring sewer service expansion once density of homes reaches 30-percent. If the threshold is passed with service expansion, financial penalties as well as building moratorium may result.
