12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This Program provides sewage pump out service to vessels anchored in waters of the Florida Keys to assist boaters in complying with State and Federal No Discharge laws to protect water quality for public health and the economically and ecologically important marine ecosystem of the Florida Keys. Since the Program's inception, over 3,200 boaters have been served diverting over 2.5 million gallons of vessel sewage from Keys' waters. This funding will ensure continued water quality protection.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The Program provides a mobile pump out service to vessels anchored throughout the Florida Keys to encourage boaters compliance with No Discharge laws to protect water quality for public health and our sensitive marine environment. The service is provided free to boaters to incentivize participation and reduce the potential for illegal discharges.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is all recreational live-aboard anchored vessel owners (both transient and local) throughout waters of the Florida Keys. The number of individuals expected to be served is 200-300 anchored boaters who require weekly pump out service as well as additional transient/seasonal boaters

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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This program collects thousands of gallons of vessel sewage annually from waters within the Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary. This preserves water quality for public health and the marine environment by eliminating the potential for illegal discharges of this highly concentrated wastewater pollutant. These water quality protections also support a multi-million dollar commercial and recreational fishing industry as well a a robust tourism industry that provides recreational fishing, diving and boating opportunities to 4 million tourists annually and contributes to a \$4 billion dollar annual economy in the Keys.
