The city was awarded CDBG-CV funds totaling \$1,012,565.00. The funds will be used for housing and utility assistance, for meals to COVID-affected individuals, and for small business grants.

Åpprox. \$2.1 million as sub-recipient of Miami-Dade County to primarily reimburse the city for COVID-related operating expenditures.

\$183,000 through DOJ to cover COVID-related police overtime.

Additionally the city is seeking approx. \$3 million in public assistance funding from FEMA for reimbursement of COVID-related expenditures.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The City of Homestead is seeking to enhance the Cybrarium facility with additional spaces allocated for community flex space that can be used to house local cultural programs, host library programs, and serve as an affordable community events space.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The community flex space will house local cultural programs, host library programs, and serve as an affordable community events space.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The community flex space will house local cultural programs, host library programs, and serve as an affordable community events space. The free wifi and technology available also helps to bridge the "digital divide."

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project will benefit 100% of the city's service area. The city serves areas outside of city limits (unincorporated Miami-Dade County). The city expects to serve more than 1,084,841 residents of Homestead and Miami-Dade County who are currently registered library users.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will



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be measured?

The community flex space will house local cultural programs, host library programs, and serve as an affordable community events space. Increased cultural programming is one of the main purposes of building out the additional meeting and community flex space. Space usage and event attendance will be tracked to show increased availability of these experiences. The Cybrarium will partner with local schools to provide unique programming and enhanced extracurricular programming. The number and content of partnerships with local schools will be tracked and reported. In addition, jobs will be created because additional staff will need to be hired at the Cybrarium in order to administer this additional space.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Standard contract penalties will be sufficient.
